Step 5: Review Facilities and Cost Considerations

- Specific facilities are listed by their value ranking based on price, lowest to highest
- Clicking on the facility will show address, phone, map link and physicians who practice at each facility



Step 6: Review Professionals and Quality

- This page displays information about the facility. In addition, the physicians who practice at that facility are listed
- When appropriate and available, quality information links to the provider's Health Grades profile
- Always call provider to verify network and price
